About the role

Working as part of the NW Metro Consortium, you'll be leading an exciting new 12 month project to assist GPs, medical specialists, chronic disease support services and specialist palliative care services to work together to deliver high quality person and family centred care for people living with a life-limiting illness in the last 12-18 months of life.

Duties

- Explore options for improvements in the ways GPs, medical specialists, chronic disease support services and specialist palliative care services can work together to assist people when palliative care support or a palliative approach is first being considered (prior to specialist palliative care involvement).
- Document the preferred approaches to ensure appropriate ongoing support is available for people being considered for 'discharge' by community palliative care services.
- Establish and implement a sustainable range of communication methods to disseminate and share project related information with GPs, medical specialists, chronic disease support services and specialist palliative care services, throughout and beyond the life of the project.

Skills & experience

- A tertiary qualification in health/social science or related discipline and/or project management.
- Knowledge of the health and community services system in metropolitan Melbourne for people with a life limiting illness and their carers/family, including specialist palliative care services, primary care services and chronic disease support services.
- Capacity to inspire health and community service staff to collaborate in seeking quality improvement in end
 of life and palliative care.
